

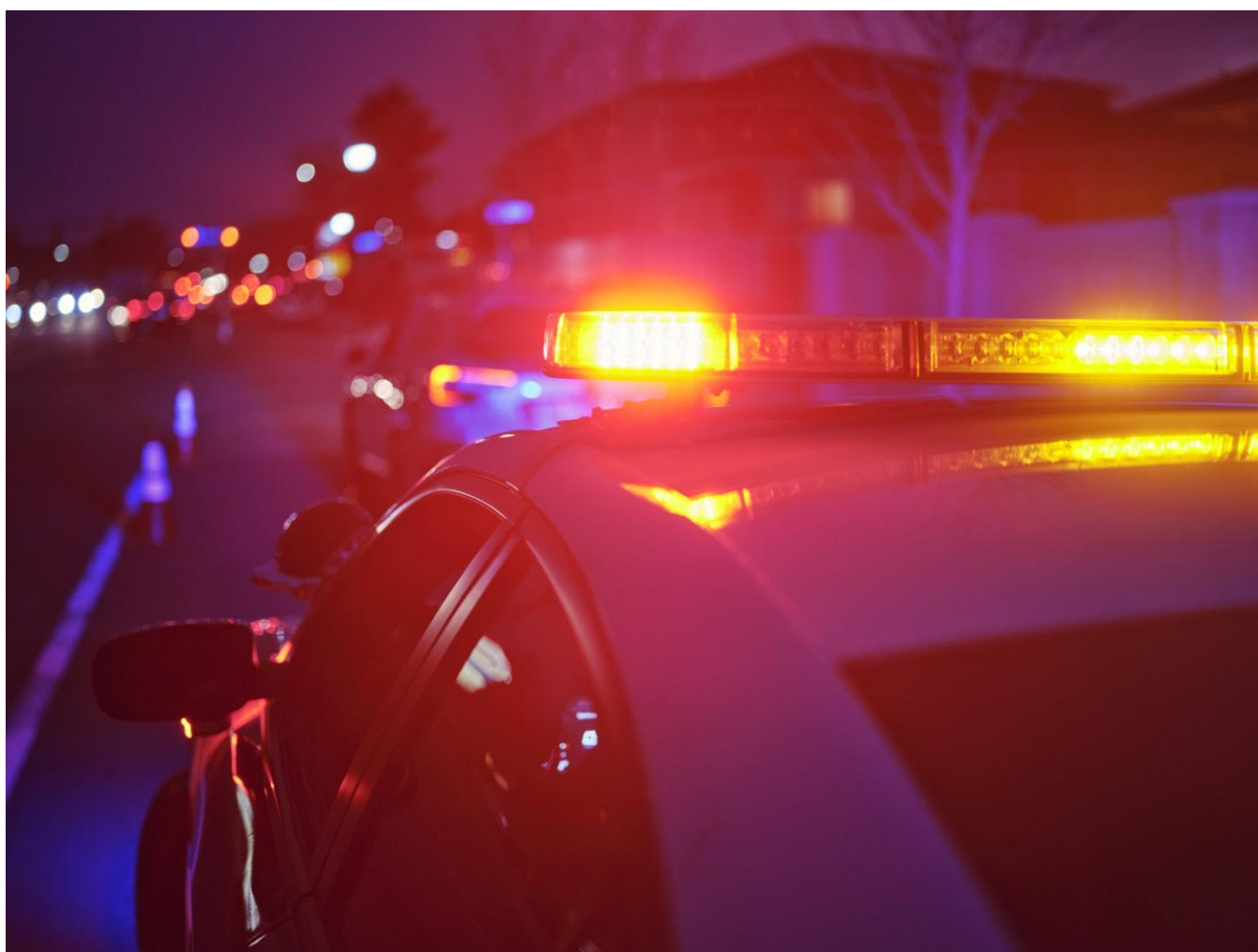

HOW WZ HELPS: WZ helps you choose the right training, supplies accurate course and delivery information, organizes the support documents you need, and helps you identify the next official contact. The applicant, veteran, agency, VA, funder, workforce board, employer or procurement authority makes the final eligibility and payment decision.

Your benefit depends on the exact exam, prep course, school program, delivery mode, location, benefit chapter and current approval record, not simply the WZ or CFI name.

01 START HERE

Do these four actions in order

The goal is to avoid paying for the wrong item, using more entitlement than expected or relying on an old approval announcement.

1

Name the civilian job you want

Examples: corporate investigator, asset protection or loss prevention leader, workplace investigator, HR/ER professional, compliance investigator, law-enforcement investigator, internal affairs, fraud investigator, threat-management or security professional.

2

Choose the exact WZ item

Record whether you mean a WZ course, on-demand course, CFI exam, CFI preparation or a structured program. Include title, provider/awarding body, dates, delivery mode, location and price.

3

Verify the exact funding route before paying

Search the live VA tools and ask VA, a State Approving Agency, School Certifying Official, VR&E counselor, service credentialing office, American Job Center, employer or POST body—as applicable.

4

Keep a complete proof file

Save screenshots or printouts of current approval, written preapproval, invoice, receipt, enrollment, completion, exam result and submitted claim confirmation.

CURRENT-STATUS NOTICE

As of this guide's source-review date, this document does not represent that the CFI exam, CFI prep, a WZ course, WZ institution, live virtual delivery, an in-person location or Human Risk Academy course is currently approved for GI Bill® payment. Verify the exact item in the live VA record before you enroll, pay or file a claim.

Never send these through a unsecured form:

- Social Security number, VA file number or bank information.
- Discharge paperwork, full claims file or complete Certificate of Eligibility.
- Detailed medical or disability information.
- Sensitive service, employment, case or security information.

WZ needs only ordinary contact information, your career goal, the exact training item, timing, delivery preference and the benefit path you are exploring.

02 CIVILIAN CAREER

Match WZ skills to the work you want

WZ training can help translate military experience into practical, explainable civilian capabilities. Employers—not WZ or VA—set hiring and certification requirements.

The Certified Forensic Interviewer (CFI) designation can provide a recognized way to show knowledge across investigative-interview domains. It does not guarantee employment, promotion, licensure, POST credit or VA reimbursement. Confirm the role's actual requirements.

03 SKILL PLAN

Build a WZ learning and credential path

Start at the level that fits your experience and target role. Ask WZ to confirm the current sequence, eligibility, format and dates.



FROM FOUNDATION SKILLS TO PRACTICAL APPLICATION AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT.

Build the foundation

1

Level I learning focuses on evidence-based investigative-interview principles, preparation, rapport, question strategy and practical application. Select the private-sector, HR/ER or law-enforcement path that matches your work.

Practice at the next level

2

Level II or practical-application training can deepen planning, delivery and feedback through role-relevant scenarios.

Add a specialty

3

Choose workplace investigative interviewing, trauma-informed interviewing, tactical field interviewing, interviewer bias, remote interviews, de-escalation, internal affairs, homicide, child abuse, workplace violence or another current WZ-supported focus.

Prepare for a credential when it helps

4

If CFI fits your career plan, confirm experience and examination requirements, current preparation options, the awarding organization and recertification obligations.

Keep the skill current

5

Use continuing education, supervisor feedback, scenario practice, free WZ resources, the IAI professional network and the credential renewal process.



WHO AWARDS CFI?

The CFI designation is administered and awarded by the International Association of Interviewers (IAI), not by VA. WZ provides related learning and preparation. Current eligibility, exam, renewal and fee rules must be confirmed with the official CFI/IAI source.



Human Risk Academy is WZ's on-demand learning environment. Online availability is not VA approval; the exact prep course or school program and modality must match the live record.

04 FUNDING CHOICE

Choose the benefit that best fits the goal

Compare price, approval, timing and entitlement before using the GI Bill. A different program may cover more of the cost or preserve education benefits.

PRESERVE ENTITLEMENT WHEN ANOTHER ROUTE FITS

A GI Bill claim may use entitlement. Compare the amount you expect to receive with VR&E, military credentialing assistance, WIOA, employer funding, agency budgets and POST reimbursement before deciding. Ask VA for an individual estimate.

05 EXACT ITEM

Identify precisely what you plan to buy

Approval is item specific. Do not search only "WZ" or rely on a broad statement that training is covered.

CAREER RESULT

Target role or promotion; employer or industry; skill or credential the role values.

EXACT TRAINING OR EXAM

Full title; course vs. prep course vs. CFI exam; WZ/provider name; IAI/awarding body; start/end date.

DELIVERY AND PRICE

In person, live virtual or asynchronous; location; hours; tuition/course fee; exam fee; mandatory and optional costs.



FUNDING ROUTES TO VERIFY

GI Bill test, GI Bill prep, approved program, VR&E, COOL, WIOA, employer, agency or POST.

Ask WZ for these facts

- ☐ Exact current title, description, hours, dates, modality, location and price.
- ☐ Whether the item is a general course, licensing/certification prep course or part of a structured school program.
- ☐ Provider's full legal name and address; credentialing organization and exam title when applicable.
- ☐ Receipt, invoice, enrollment, attendance/progress, completion and exam-preparation verification that WZ can supply.
- ☐ Current WZ knowledge of approval status—followed by your own live verification with VA or the controlling authority.

HISTORIC APPROVAL IS NOT CURRENT PROOF

An old press release, benefit payment, screenshot or coworker's reimbursement can be a useful lead, but it does not prove that your exact 2026 item, fee, modality, location or benefit is approved. Verify again.

06 VA VERIFICATION

Search the live VA tools

Use the VA tool that matches the item. Save the result and contact VA when the listing or payment effect is unclear.

1

Confirm your education benefit

If you have not applied, use VA's education application page. If you have a Certificate of Eligibility, review it, but do not send the full document through a WZ marketing form.

2

Search the exact exam or prep course

Open the licenses, certifications and prep-course search. Enter the full credential name, use category type "Both" when appropriate, and open the detail record.

3

Search an exact school program

Use the GI Bill Comparison Tool. Find the institution, then confirm the specific approved program—not only the institution name. Match modality and location.



4

Record the approval facts

Save the name, category, state if applicable, approved amount, provider/awarding body, effective information and date you checked.

5

Ask VA the cost to your entitlement

Before paying, ask which chapter applies, likely reimbursement, entitlement charge and whether any housing or other payment is expected. Do not assume.

VA EDUCATION CALL CENTER

Use the current contact page for hours and options. VA lists 888-GIBILL-1 (888-442-4551) for education questions. Ask about the exact item and the effect on your entitlement.

07 CREDENTIAL EXAM

Request test-fee reimbursement

Use this route only for a licensing or certification test. A course fee, membership, credential document fee and optional study material are different costs.

1

Search before you test

Use VA's licenses/certifications search. Confirm the exact exam and the current approved amount. If it is not listed, follow VA's current instructions and ask whether it can still be considered.



2

Take the exam and keep proof

Keep the itemized testing-fee receipt and a copy of the test result, license or certification evidence. VA says an approved test can be reimbursed even after a failed attempt or certain retakes, subject to remaining entitlement and rules.

3

Complete VA Form 22-0803

Use the current online or downloadable form. Enter the exact test and awarding organization. Follow the form instructions.

4

Submit through an official channel

VA's current page directs applicants to upload through QuickSubmit or mail to the regional processing office. Keep the completed form and confirmation.

5

Check the entitlement effect

VA currently states it may reimburse up to \$2,000 per approved test, but the approved amount, benefit rules and entitlement charge control. The fee for the actual license or certificate document is generally not the test fee.

Your test claim checklist

- ☐ Current approval record or search result.
- ☐ Exact test name and credentialing organization.
- ☐ Itemized receipt showing the testing fee.
- ☐ Test result or license/certification evidence.
- ☐ Completed VA Form 22-0803.
- ☐ QuickSubmit or mailing confirmation and a copy of everything sent.

CFI CHECK

If you are considering the CFI exam, search the exact current CFI listing and approved fee. Confirm that the credentialing organization and exam record match what you will purchase. Do not rely on historic coverage announcements alone.



08 PREP COURSE

Request prep-course reimbursement

VA prep-course reimbursement has narrower rules than a general WZ course. The course must prepare for a VA-approved licensing or certification test.

1

Confirm the associated test

Search and verify the exact licensing or certification test first. VA approves prep courses only for tests it has approved.

2

Confirm the exact prep course

The course must be listed or otherwise confirmed under the current VA process. A course being useful for an exam is not enough.

3

Confirm benefit eligibility

VA Form 22-10272 states that prep-course reimbursement is available to eligible Post-9/11 GI Bill (Chapter 33) or Survivors' and Dependents' Educational Assistance (Chapter 35) beneficiaries.

4

Complete the course and keep proof

Keep the itemized receipt and proof of enrollment from WZ or the provider. The form calls for one prep course per form and distinguishes mandatory fees from optional costs.

5

Submit VA Form 22-10272

Follow the current form and VA page. Upload through QuickSubmit or mail to the proper VA regional processing office. Keep the full submission and confirmation.

Ask WZ to confirm what it can provide

- ☐ Exact prep-course title and provider legal name/address.
- ☐ Associated credentialing exam and awarding organization.
- ☐ Start/end dates, delivery mode and enrollment verification.
- ☐ Itemized mandatory course fees and receipt.
- ☐ Completion or participation record available under the course design.

DO NOT RELABEL A GENERAL COURSE

A WZ class should never be described as a VA-approved prep course unless the exact course and associated test satisfy the current approval record. Use the truthful course category and ask VA when uncertain.

09 PROGRAM ROUTE

Understand school-program approval

GI Bill approval of a non-college training program is an institutional process. An isolated seminar, traveling class, live virtual class or on-demand course is not automatically covered.

What must be true before WZ markets a program as approved

- 1 The correct State Approving Agency is involved**
Because WZ is based in Illinois, Illinois is an important starting point, but jurisdiction can depend on the institution, modality and training location. The SAA decides its process.
- 2 The institution and exact program are approved**
The approval file can include catalog, tuition/fees, clock hours, attendance, progress, grading, refund/leave, prior-credit review, instructors, facilities, finances and other state/VA requirements.
- 3 The delivery mode and location match**
In-person, live virtual and asynchronous structures must match the approval. New locations, tuition, schedules or online delivery can be reportable changes.
- 4 School operations are in place**
Approved programs require trained School Certifying Officials, VA systems, student records, prior-training evaluation and compliance with current enrollment and reporting rules.
- 5 The veteran verifies the program in the live tool**
Even if WZ completes provider approval, the learner should confirm the exact program and discuss entitlement and payment with VA before enrolling.

INTERNAL WZ PROVIDER ROADMAP

WZ should continue the provider-side work separately: revalidate any CFI test/prep status; engage the correct SAA; build the institutional file; approve each delivery mode/location; establish School Certifying Official operations; and publish only exact, current approval language with the GI Bill® trademark notice.

MONTHLY ENROLLMENT VERIFICATION

VA states that beginning in January 2026, education beneficiaries—including Chapter 35—must verify enrollment monthly to receive benefit payments. If you use an approved school-program route, follow the current VA and School Certifying Official instructions.

10 EMPLOYMENT PLAN

Ask about VA Veteran Readiness and Employment

VR&E can be a better fit than GI Bill reimbursement for an eligible veteran whose service-connected disability affects employment and who needs training for suitable work.

1

Review basic eligibility

Use the official VR&E page. Eligibility and entitlement are different; VA makes the determination.

2

Apply and meet with a counselor

Explain the civilian role, how your service-connected condition affects employment and the training or credential needed for suitable work.

3

Connect WZ training to the employment goal

Bring the exact course or credential, learning objectives, dates, modality, price and role connection. The counselor decides whether it belongs in the individualized plan.

4

Get written authorization before enrolling

Do not assume a receipt will be reimbursed later. Confirm vendor, invoice, payment, attendance and completion steps.

5

Keep the plan and proof

Save counselor authorization, WZ quote/invoice, approved purchase method, attendance/completion and any employment-plan follow-up.

Plain-language counselor explanation

My employment goal is [role]. The role requires or values [skill/credential]. My current gap is [specific capability]. The exact WZ item is [title, hours, mode and dates]. It teaches [three relevant outcomes]. The cost is [amount]. I am asking whether this item can be approved in my VR&E plan before I enroll.

WZ CAN PREPARE A COUNSELOR PACKET

WZ can provide a factual course description, objectives, duration, modality, schedule, quote, provider information and available completion documentation. WZ cannot determine VR&E eligibility or approve the plan.

11 OTHER SUPPORT

Use COOL, WIOA, employer or POST funding

These routes can be faster, can preserve GI Bill entitlement and may better match a role-required course. Every route requires preapproval under its current rules.

Army COOL / Army credentialing assistance	Search the credential and follow current Army funding workflow.	Are funds available, is the vendor approved, and what documents and deadlines apply?	Army credential search
American Job Center / WIOA	Contact the local center; veterans and eligible spouses have priority of service in DOL-funded programs, but eligibility and local services vary.	Am I eligible for training, and must this exact program/provider be on the state ETPL?	Find an AJC
Employer professional development	Give the manager a role connection, course facts, price and time away. Get approval in writing.	What costs, proof, repayment agreement or continued-service rule applies?	WZ training
Agency / POST reimbursement	Ask the training unit or state POST body before enrollment.	Is this course/instructor approved for credit or reimbursement? What roster and deadline apply?	IADLEST POST portal
Veteran-serving nonprofit / scholarship	Use a genuine mission-aligned program; individual grants are uncommon.	Who is eligible, what is funded and is payment made to the learner or provider?	Candid search

VETERANS' PRIORITY OF SERVICE

The U.S. Department of Labor states that veterans and eligible spouses receive priority of service in DOL-funded job-training programs, including WIOA. Priority does not automatically establish eligibility or guarantee that a specific WZ course will be approved.

12 DELIVERY CHOICE

Choose in-person, live virtual or on-demand

Select the format that fits your learning and job plan—but verify that the approval record matches the exact format and location.

QUESTION	IN PERSON / LIVE VIRTUAL	ASYNCHRONOUS / ON-DEMAND
Approval	Exact program, location or approved live structure must match.	Exact online course/modality and approved hours must match.
Learning experience	Scheduled instructor interaction, peer practice and immediate feedback.	Self-paced access and flexible schedule; practice and feedback depend on design.
Proof	Roster, clock hours, attendance, progress and completion.	Verified participation, progress, completion and approved hours.
Changes	New location, schedule, price or structure may require notice/approval.	Moving online or changing self-paced structure may require notice/approval.
Payment / entitlement	Depends on benefit, program, rate of pursuit, dates and structure.	Online-only and short-course rules can change payment and entitlement.

Ask before enrolling

- ☐ Is this exact exam, prep course or school program currently approved?
- ☐ Does approval cover this location and delivery mode?
- ☐ Which benefit chapter applies, how much might be paid and how much entitlement may be charged?
- ☐ What will WZ give me, and what must I send to VA or another program?
- ☐ Will this short or online program create a housing allowance? Do not assume.
- ☐ What changes if the schedule, delivery mode, provider, price or location changes?

NO HOUSING PROMISE

Short, clock-hour and online programs have specific payment and rate-of-pursuit rules. Use the VA Comparison Tool and VA counseling for your own estimate. WZ should not promise a housing allowance.

Store one secure digital copy and one backup. Use clear filenames such as 2026-07-28_CFI-Search-Result.pdf and 2026-09-10_VA-22-0803-Confirmation.pdf. Keep sensitive benefit records out of ordinary email and marketing systems.

CONTACT WZ WITH A SIMPLE REQUEST

Share your civilian role goal, exact course or credential, delivery preference, timing and funding route. Ask WZ for a “veteran benefits course-information packet.” WZ can guide the training information; the benefit authority makes the payment decision.

5 ANSWER CENTER

Common questions and legal notes

These short answers are designed for veterans, counselors, employers, web visitors and outreach campaigns.

Can I use the GI Bill for WZ training?

Possibly, but only when the exact exam, prep course or school program is approved for the applicable benefit and your individual claim qualifies. A WZ brand name or old announcement is not enough.

Can the GI Bill reimburse the CFI exam?

Search the live VA licensing/certification tool for the exact CFI exam and approved fee. If it is not listed or details do not match, contact VA before paying.

Can the GI Bill reimburse CFI prep or another WZ course?

A prep course must prepare for a VA-approved test and the exact prep course must satisfy VA’s current process. A general interview class should not be relabeled as prep.

Can online WZ training be covered?

Only if the exact online item and modality are approved under the funding route. On-demand availability alone is not approval.

How can WZ training help my civilian career?

It can build explainable skills in investigative interviewing, workplace investigations, HR/ER, loss prevention, fraud, compliance, public safety, de-escalation, workplace violence and threat management. Hiring rules vary.

What if GI Bill reimbursement is not a good fit?

Ask about VR&E, military credentialing assistance, WIOA/American Job Center funding, employer development, agency training budgets, POST reimbursement or a genuine veteran-serving program.

Will WZ file my VA claim?

No. WZ can provide course facts and available proof. You or your authorized representative submit the claim, and VA decides eligibility, payment and entitlement.

TALK WITH WZ
