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## PLANNING AND PREPARATION

The beginning of every investigative interview should always be initiated with the 'Planning and Preparation' phase. Your planning and preparation go well beyond simply planning the interview itself. There are several items up for consideration, such as legal aspects of the interview, the environment, subject background, the most appropriate interview method, and so on.
